Terms and Conditions: 1. All applicants must complete the full Scholarship Application Form. 2. The scholarship is open to those who are enrolled in tertiary education and are interested in working in local government or in learning about the role of Council and the different services we provide. 3. Application forms must be received by Council no later than Monday 19 October 2026, Midnight. 4. The Scholarship amount of \$1,000 is only to be used for assistance towards studying, e.g. fees, stationery, resources etc., of the nominated course of study the recipient has chosen. 5. As part of the Scholarship entitlement Horowhenua District Council will offer the recipient paid work experience at Council during the 2026 - 2027 summer holidays. The timeframe for paid work will be negotiated with the successful applicant. 6. The Scholarship amount of \$1,000 will be paid as a lump sum to the successful recipient.

Declaration

- I will only be eligible to be offered the Scholarship if enrolled at a tertiary institution in the year of tenure and in compliance with any other specific requirements of the Scholarship for which I have applied.
- Horowhenua District Council may terminate a Scholarship at any time and recoup any funds awarded, if it is satisfied that I am not following the required programme of study or not otherwise complying with the conditions governing the Scholarship.
- As a Scholarship holder, I will have the right to appeal to the People and Capability (Human Resources) Department of the Horowhenua District Council against any decision to terminate the award.

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- In compliance with the Privacy Act, information provided in this application will be used in the assessment of my application for a Scholarship and if successful will be retained on my personnel file.
